General Information:

Description: DLP Math is a curriculum that aims to help students build connections and skills between math concepts. The curriculum shows students how math concepts build on each other so they can progress to higher level skills. The curriculum also includes a focus on math skills that are essential to everyday life.

Expectations and Goals

Course Outline

Class Activities

Students will come into the room, sit down and begin completing the sponge activity or review question of the day. Following that activity, students will learn new concepts, practice the new concept through various activities and then complete homework that is assigned. Other activities may include Rocket Math, IXL, Learning Stations, and practice games.

Grading

Students are graded according to the following requirements:

Classwork / Homework: 40%

Tests / Quizzes: 60%

Late Work

Students will be given one week to hand in late work. After one week, the grade will be lowered 5 points every week up to one month. After one month, they will receive a zero. If a student is absent, they will receive two days for every day they are absent to make up missing work.

Cheating

Students are responsible for doing their own work so teachers can evaluate their strengths and weaknesses. Students caught cheating will have one opportunity to receive a new copy and complete it after school with the teacher present or receive a zero for the assignment / test.
