

Overview:

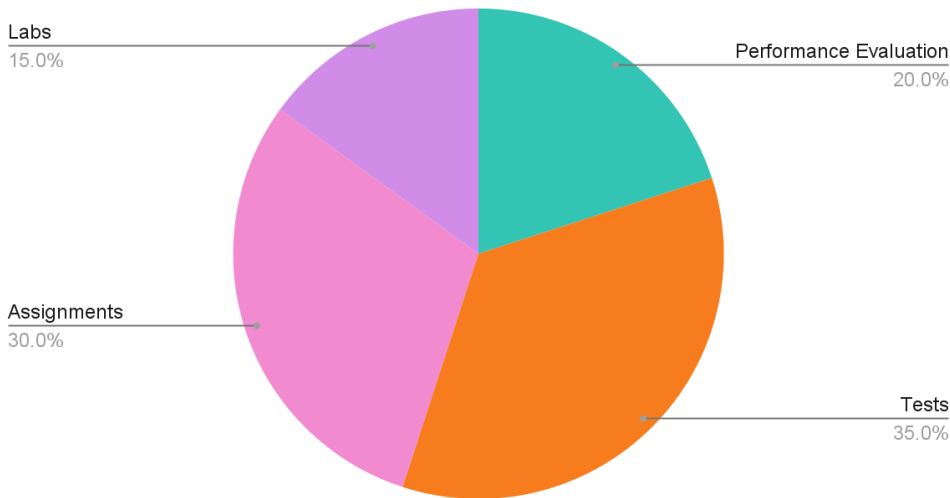
Homework Policy:
