

SUCCESSFUL STUDENTS...

- ...keep their hands to themselves.



Per school policy, students are required to keep their cell phones /AirPods put away and smart watches left alone <u>for the</u> duration of class time.

- If a cell phone rings, chimes, alarm goes off, etc. the phone will be taken away and the student has to serve a **30 minute** detention before they can get it back.
- If a student is using AirPods during class without being instructed to do so the AirPods will be taken away and the student has to serve a **30 minute detention** before they can get them back. If this happens 3 times the students AirPods will be taken away for the rest of the semester.
