READING CLASS - Mrs. Malcom 2023-2024 Syllabus

Objective: Students will learn Reading skills in the English language through the study of letter sounds, spelling, grammar and comprehension skills.

<u>Classroom Expectations</u>: Students are expected to behave in a **RESPECTFUL** manner within the classroom and school wide.
