What We Do In Class

- ★ Students will rotate to various groups throughout the week. Groups will consist of:
 - Ipad
 - Small Group Instruction w/Teacher
 - Independent work (Stations)
 - Writing/Vocabulary
- ★ Some days will be reserved for whole class re-teaching, quizzes, and tests.

DLP Geography

This course provides an introduction to study of the world through the geographic perspective. The course will study the impact and major themes of geography, the acquiring of geospatial literacy, the understanding of the environmental, cultural, and economic differences of various regions around the earth, the major types of governments, and political structures of society, and develop a further knowledge of the impact that globalization has on our world today.

* Independent /Group stations will help you practice to further build your skills and confidence.

*Teacher guided instruction is provided to make sure targeted skills are all working together.

Policies and Procedures

All school policies will be enforced in this class.

Hall Passes?

- ★ Passes will be given on the basis of extreme emergency at the discretion of the teacher.
- ★ Do not request a pass to get water or go to see a guidance counselor. (Guidance will send passes for scheduled meetings, and they can be scheduled during lunch/before or after school)

Entering the room?

- ★ You are to come prepared for class and ready to work. Paper, workbook, sharpened pencils/pen should be brought to class each day, unless you are instructed to do otherwise by the teacher.
- ★ Enter the room quietly and calmly before the bell.
- ★ Get all materials before you find your assigned seat, and follow the instructions given on the board/projector.

Throwing things away?

- ★ You don't have to ask.
- ★ Please quietly get up, one at a time, if the teacher is talking to the class wait until finished.
- ★ Please do not throw things across the room.

Sharpening your pencil?

- ★ Please make sure you have at least 2 sharpened pencils for the start of class.
- ★ Try to sharpen all pencils before the bell or during group transitions.
- ★ You don't have to ask during the designated times.
- ★ If the teacher or other students are talking to the class, please wait until they are finished.

Eating and drinking in class?

- ★ No eating in class.
- ★ The only drink permitted in class is a bottle of water with a twist on lid and must be kept away from ipad area. *This is a privilege! If the privilege is abused, it will be taken away.*

Participation in Class?
