### **Grades are primarily comprised of the following:**

- Project Engineer Notebook - the only thing allowed to use on the test. Each project will contain hand drawn schematics properly marked, key definitions, and notes.
  - 0 not turned in or no work shown - 0% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
  - 1 not complete or missing two of the following key definitions, schematics, or notes with little effort put into the project - 25% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
  - 2 not complete or missing key definitions, schematics, or notes - 25% Lowest grade you can receive on a test
  - 3 or 4 not complete or missing key definitions, schematics, or notes. Small errors apparent like schematics not marked properly or errors and missing information in notes or definitions - 25% Lowest grade you can receive on a test
  - 5 Complete notebook key definitions, schematics, and notes - 50% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
  - Engineering notebook due the day before Exams for Grade Check/Interview

- Project Completion
  - 0 project not completed
  - 1 project completed but unsafe and distracting behavior during lab time.
  - 2 project completed with many errors
  - 3 Project completed with two or more errors
  - 4 Project completed
  - 5 Project completed along with an extra change.
- Assessment worth 100 pts each
  - Exams can only be retaken for 70%. After showing a completed lab notebook.
- Semester One Final (100 Points) **\*Cannot be retaken or**
- Semester Two Final (100 points) **\*Cannot be retaken or**

Grades for each Semester of Highschool Credit will be divided among the following categories:
