GRADING POLICY

SEMESTER TEST GRADE:

1ST SEMESTER - QT1- 45% / QT 2- 45% / 1ST SEMESTER TEST = 10% (THERE WILL BE A FINAL SEMESTER TEST AT THE END OF EACH SEMESTER)

2ND SEMESTER - QT 3 – 45%/QT 4- 45% / 2ND SEMESTER TEST =10% (THERE WILL BE A FINAL SEMESTER TEST AT THE END OF EACH SEMESTER)

**MISSING OR UNEXCUSED LATE WORK WILL NOT BE GIVEN FULL CREDIT. WORK NOT DONE WILL NEED TO BE DONE WITHIN 3 DAYS OF THE DUE DATE, IT'LL BE AUTOMATICALLY 70% IN THE GRADE BOOK.THIS CAN BE TURNED IN BEFORE OR AFTER SCHOOL UNLESS OTHER ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE. UNEXCUSED MISSING WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER 3 DAYS FOR A GRADE AND WILL RECEIVE A ZERO. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REDO ASSIGNMENTS IF THEY HAVE BEEN HANDED IN LATE.

BEHAVIOR

CHECKING GRADES
