LET'S TALK ABOUT THOSE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

<u>BUFFETT SCHOLARSHIP</u> - The student will have to enter the *email address* of one recommender. The recommender will then answer a series of questions about the student's work ethic, leadership, strengths and weaknesses, motivation and goals, as well as witnessing selflessness, caring for others, and/or giving back to the community.

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS -The student will have to enter the *email addresses of two people*. We encourage the students to include a teacher and past or present employer as several scholarships require this to be considered. The outside recommender can be anyone EXCEPT a family relative or friend. Students need to read each scholarship description for specific requirements on this area.

<u>OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS</u> - There are several scholarship opportunities that may require a physical copy of the recommendation letter. Be aware of individual scholarship requirements as they will vary.

It is common etiquette to ask the person FIRST before listing them as a recommender. Seniors should provide the recommender a copy of their resume so the recommender has a total "picture" of the student.

**** Other Side Notes ****

- ~ Please check General Scholarships on our school websites for upcoming scholarship deadlines. All of our scholarships can be found on the high school homepage.
- \sim Start paying attention to what fines are owed. Before graduating in May, all fines must be paid. These would include lanyard fines, lunch balances, library fines, and computer fines.
