2023/2024 FAFSA COMPLETION DAYS

EducationQuest Foundation, a free non-profit organization, will meet with your family to help complete and file your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

BEFORE YOUR FAMILY CAN SIGN UP FOR AN APPOINTMENT BOTH THE STUDENT *AND* PARENT ARE **REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR FSA ID**. EACH SENIOR STUDENT HAS A BLUE SHEET WHERE THEY HAVE PUT THEIR INFORMATION. WE ARE ASKING THE PARENTS TO ALSO FILL THEIR PORTION OUT ON THIS SHEET. WHEN THIS IS COMPLETE, PLEASE HAVE THE SENIOR STUDENT COME IN TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT.
