**5031 STUDENT APPEARANCE** 

Any manner of dress, hair style, make up, cleanliness, or personal appearance that constitutes a threat to the safety, health,

welfare, or morals of the student or others; violates any statute; interferes with the education process, or school officials can

reasonably predict will interfere with the education process; or causes or may cause excessive maintenance problems in the

school, may be grounds for corrective or disciplinary action. The superintendent or designee may institute specific dress

code regulations in any school consistent with board policy.
