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Classroom Objective: Students will learn to read, write, speak, and listen in English through a variety of different topics in the language arts.

Grading:

Each student's grade will be a result of total points earned from the following categories: **Participation: 20%**

Projects/Tests/Quizzes: 40%

Homework/Daily Assignments: 40%

Participation: Students will be able to earn 5 points per day, for a total of 25 points per week. Ways that someone could lose points are for the following reasons: late, disrupting the class, absent, refusing to do the work in class, cheating, and ISS or OSS. Points may not be earned back.

Cheating/Plagiarism: Will result in a **ZERO** and all participation points lost for the week. Cheating/plagiarism is not tolerated. You are responsible for **YOUR OWN** work don't take others' ideas or work and think it's okay to make them your own.
