TUTORING

UPDATED ATTENDANCE POLICY

Lexington Public Schools has made an update to its Attendance Policy. The policy is included with this newsletter. Please make sure to look these changes over.

Below are a few highlights from the policy:

- **Any student who misses any class more than 10 times unexcused will be removed from that class and receive an F on their transcript.**
- **Students must not acquire more than the equivalent of 20 school day absences in a school year to avoid being turned over to the County Attorney for attendance violations.**
- **Students who are absent for 10 or more consecutive days will be dropped from the district's enrollment.**

GRADES/CREDITS

Please have conversations with your student(s) about their grades. At Lexington High School there are credit requirements in order to graduate. It is important that your student(s) do not fall behind with their grades.
