Class Description

In this class, we will be focusing on the importance of reading and writing while making text-to-self, text-to-world, text-text connections. We will learn how to apply reading and writing skills in different contexts. Students will be using StudySync to complete reading and writing assignments. This class will also emphasize the importance of vocabulary, reading comprehension, fluency in writing and reading, and independent work. English students will also be exposed to a variety of short stories to enhance their understanding of English literature and the world around them. The goal of this class is to prepare students to be efficient readers, writers, and learners.

Revisions will be allowed on most assignments, but students can only receive up to 80%. Revisions are only allowed on work that is turned in on time and to students who come meet face to face with the instructor during homeroom or after school.

Expectations

Students are expected to follow directions and behave following the classroom rules and student handbook. It is also expected that students create a welcoming environment for themselves and others. Students are expected to use iPads for class and ONLY when directed by Mrs. Perez.
