Objective:

Students will learn how to read, write, and speak in English through the study of vocabulary and concepts of Earth Science and Life Science.

Classroom Expectations: Students are expected to behave in a **RESPECTFUL** manner within the classroom and school wide.

*Students will demonstrate **RESPECT** by following school rules and showing kindness towards adults and other students. Students will also be respectful of school property.

Consequences:

Any disruptive behavior or disrespectful language will result in the following consequences:

*1 verbal warning: You will be asked once to change your behavior.

*Detention before or after school for 30 minutes. 30 minutes will be added each day until you serve the detention. (Accumulating to 2 hours)

*You have 4 days to serve your detention before I ask the office to add your name to the ISS list.

After your ISS day you must serve a 1 hour detention with me.

Some behaviors that can result in a detention are: being tardy for class, sleeping, using disrespectful words in any language, using your phone during class, talking or making noises, putting on makeup, leaving the room without permission, cheating, or using your computer inappropriately (gaming, YouTube, etc).

Ipad Use:

The Ipad you use in this class belongs to the school !

This means that it should only be used for educational purposes while you are at school. Any inappropriate use of the Ipad at home or at school will result in it being taken away from you for a time. **Your Ipad needs to be charged each day when you come to school and you need to have your charger with you every day. DO NOT SHARE YOUR CHARGER!**

If you lose your charger you will need to pay \$35 for a new charger.

Food and Drink:

Please do not bring coffee, soda, or outside food to class. Your drink bottle must have a lid.
You should not have open drinks near your Ipad.
