Your child is preparing to enter kindergarten. The following are steps that should be completed before your child begins kindergarten.

Kindergarten Steps

- ♥ Beginning in MARCH, make an appointment with a doctor for a physical exam for your child
- ♥ Most children going into kindergarten may need more vaccines. Therefore, take your child's vaccine records to your physical exam appointment
- ♥ Vaccines can be administered at the following:

Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska. In Lexington there are public immunization clinics on the 1^{st} & 3^{rd} Mondays of every month. Call 308 324-5733 or 308-325-3169 to schedule appointments.

Two Rivers Public Health Clinic held on the first Friday of each month. An appointment MUST be made prior to the clinic day. To make an appointment, call Maria at 308-991-4272.

- ♥ Schedule an appointment for an eye exam with an eye doctor if one was not done when your child had their physical exam
- ♥ Nebraska State Law requires these steps for admission to Public Schools
